The consultation policy will be supported by an issues resolution procedure to ensure that all workers are given the opportunity to express their views and contribute in a timely manner to the resolution of health and safety issues that affect them. These views will be valued and taken into account by those making operational decisions.

The consultation arrangements will be monitored and reviewed as the need arises to ensure they continue to be meaningful and effective and meet the needs of the business and our team.
